



## **NVIH POSITION DESCRIPTION**

### **STERILIZATION TECHNICIAN – RED BLUFF**

**REPORTS TO:** Lead R.D.A.

**SUPERVISES:** None

**POSITION SUMMARY:** Position works directly with and under the supervision of the Lead R.D.A in providing and managing the sterilization of all dental equipment.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Maintaining the instruments and working areas in strict accordance with sterilization/disinfection protocols.
2. Preparing and arranging instruments, medications and required material.
3. Preparing patients for dental health services and services and instructing them in appropriate post dental treatment, diet and oral hygiene.
4. Promptly following all instructions from the dentist as it pertains to patient treatment.
5. Taking inventory, stocking all supplies, instruments and medications.
6. Exposing and processing dental x-rays and maintenance of x-ray machinery.
7. Performing required laboratory procedures, i.e., pouring plaster models, etc.
8. Using four-handed assisting technique as called upon.
9. Maintaining dental equipment and operatories in good, clean condition at all times.
10. Cross-training in other dental support positions as necessary, i.e., reception, orthodontics, oral surgery.
11. Maintaining personnel protection per OSHA guidelines as it pertains to personnel safety, i.e., protective clothing, eyewear, gloves.
12. Participating in in-service training, department and general staff meetings and clinics.
13. Performing other duties as assigned by the Supervisor.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Possession of a valid State of California Dental X-ray license.
2. High School Diploma or equivalent, GED.
3. Completion of a dental assist training academic program, or 1-2 years experience on-the-job training.
4. Current CPR BLS certification.
5. Valid California driver's license and proof of personal liability automobile insurance as required by California state law.
6. Punctuality, accuracy, efficiency and professionalism.
7. Indian Preference. Preference in filling vacancies is given to qualified Indian candidates in accordance with the Indian Preference Act (Title 25, U.S. Code Section 472 & 473). In other than the above, Northern Valley Indian Health, Inc. is an Equal Opportunity Employer.

**LANGUAGE SKILLS:** Ability to read, analyze, and interpret common scientific and technical journals, financial reports, and legal documents. Ability to respond to common inquiries or complaints from customers, regulatory agencies, or members of the business community.

Ability to effectively present information to top management, public groups, and/or boards of directors.

**MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:** Ability to calculate figures and amounts such as discounts, interest, commissions, proportions, percentages, area, circumference, and volume. Ability to apply concepts of basic algebra and geometry.

**REASONING ABILITY:** Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions. Ability to interpret an extensive variety of technical instructions in mathematical or diagram form and deal with several abstract and concrete variables. Ability to apply principles of logical or scientific thinking to a wide range of intellectual and practical problems. Ability to deal with nonverbal symbolism (formulas, scientific equations, graphs, musical notes, etc.) in its most difficult phases. Ability to deal with a variety of abstract and concrete variables.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to communicate and listen.
